BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-19-102(a), concerning establishments
that are required to post information about the National Human Trafficking
Hotline, is amended to read as follows:
(a) The following establishments shall post in a conspicuous place
near the entrance of the establishment, or where posters and notices of this
type customarily are posted, a poster described in subsection (b) of this
section measuring at least eight and one-half inches by eleven inches (8½ x
ll") in size:
(1) A hotel, motel, or other establishment that has been cited
as a public nuisance for prostitution under § 20-27-401;
(2) A strip club or other sexually oriented business;
(3) A private club that has a liquor permit for on-premises
consumption and does not hold itself out to be a food service establishment;
(4) An airport;

1	(5)(4) A train station that serves passengers;
2	(6) (5) A bus station;
3	(7)(6) A privately owned and operated facility that provides
4	food, fuel, shower or other sanitary facilities, and overnight parking $\underline{\text{that}}$
5	is located within one thousand three hundred and twenty feet (1,320') of an
6	interstate; and
7	(8) An abortion facility;
8	(7) A nail salon or massage business licensed by the Department
9	of Health.
