21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-19-102(a), concerning establishments
24 that are required to post information about the National Human Trafficking
25 Hotline, is amended to read as follows:

26 (a) The following establishments shall post in a conspicuous place
27 near the entrance of the establishment, or where posters and notices of this
28 type customarily are posted, a poster described in subsection (b) of this
29 section measuring at least eight and one-half inches by eleven inches (8½" x
30 11") in size:

31 (1) A hotel, motel, or other establishment that has been cited
32 as a public nuisance for prostitution under § 20-27-401;

33 (2) A strip club or other sexually oriented business;

34 (3) ~~A private club that has a liquor permit for on-premises~~
35 ~~consumption and does not hold itself out to be a food service establishment;~~

36 (4) An airport;

- 2 ~~(6)~~(5) A bus station;
- 3 ~~(7)~~(6) A privately owned and operated facility that provides
- 4 food, fuel, shower or other sanitary facilities, and overnight parking that
- 5 is located within one thousand three hundred and twenty feet (1,320') of an
- 6 interstate; and
- 7 ~~(8) An abortion facility;~~
- 8 (7) A nail salon, massage parlor, or spa.
