1	(2) A student's permanent school record shall include		
2	information regarding any disciplinary action taken against the student,		
3	including without limitation an in-school suspension, out-of-school		
4	suspension, pending expulsion, or expulsion.		
5	(b) If a student has been expelled from or is pending an expulsion		
6	from a public school or private school and transfers to a public school		
7	within his or her resident public school district, a private school, or a		
8	nonresident public school district, then the public school within the		
9	student's resident public school district, the private school, or the		
10	nonresident public school district to which the student transfers shall		
11	obtain the student's permanent school record before the public school,		
12	private school, or nonresident public school district may accept the student		
13	for transfer.		
14	(c) A public school, private school, or public school district may		
15	deny the transfer of a student who is pending expulsion proceedings or a		
16	student who is serving a period of expulsion from a public school or private		
17	school.		
18	(d) Each public school, private school, and public school district		
19	shall designate at least one (1) certified staff member or administrator to		
20	verify the accuracy of a student's permanent school record under this		
21	section.		
22	(e) An individual who knowingly provides false or incomplete		
23	information concerning a student's permanent school record under this section		
24	may be found to be in violation of the Code of Ethics for Arkansas Educators.		
25	(f) The Division of Elementary and Secondary Education shall:		
26	(1) Develop procedures for transferring permanent school records		
27	under this section; and		
28	(2) Promulgate rules to administer this section.		
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
