24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-318(a)(3)(B), concerning postmortem
27 examinations, is amended to read as follows:

28 (B)(i) The county coroner having jurisdiction where a
29 death occurs shall submit a decedent to the State Crime Laboratory for a
30 postmortem examination when the death is by apparent drug, alcohol, or poison
31 toxicity, unless ~~a significant interval passed while~~ the person was
32 hospitalized and hospital evaluation is available for review.

33 (ii) As used in subdivision (a)(3)(B)(i) of this
34 section, "hospitalized" means admitted to a hospital for inpatient treatment.
