9	AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CANVASSERS; TO
10	REQUIRE DOMICILE IN ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

13	Subtitle
14	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CANVASSERS;
15	AND TO REQUIRE DOMICILE IN ARKANSAS.
16	
17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18	
19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-9-103(a)(6), concerning residence of
20	canvassers, is amended to read as follows:
21	(6) A person shall not act as a canvasser unless he or she is :
22	<u>(A) Is</u> a resident of this state <u>; and</u>
23	(B) Is domiciled in:
24	(i) The state if acting as a canvasser for a
25	statewide initiative petition or statewide referendum petition; or
26	(ii) The county where a local petition will be
27	submitted if acting as a canvasser for a local petition.
28	
29	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-9-103(d), concerning the signing of
30	petitions, is amended to read as follows:
31	(d)(1) A person acting as a sponsor or an agent of a sponsor shall not
32	knowingly hire a person as a paid canvasser who:
33	(A) Is not a resident of this state; and
34 25	(B) Is not domiciled in:
35	(i) The state if acting as a canvasser for a
36	statewide initiative petition or statewide referendum petition; or



1	(ii) The county where a local petition will be
2	submitted if acting as a canvasser for a local petition.
3	(2) A person who fails to comply with subdivision (d)(l) of this
4	section is guilty of a violation and upon conviction shall be fined two
5	thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for each paid canvasser hired in
6	violation of subdivision (d)(l) of this section.
7	(e) When the official charged with verifying the signatures has
8	reasonable grounds to believe that one (1) or more signatures on a petition
9	is forged, the official shall report the suspected forgery and basis for
10	suspecting forgery to:
11	(1) The Division of Arkansas State Police, in the case of a
12	statewide petition; or
13	(2) The prosecuting attorney of the county, in the case of a
14	local petition.
15	
16	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Severability.</u>
17	If any provision of this act or the application of this act to any
18	person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other
19	provisions or applications of this act which can be given effect without the
20	invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this act
21	are declared severable.
