25	registration and report	ting requirement for eligibility for	benefits under the

27	(2) Regist	tration and Reporting. He or she ha	s registered for
28	work at and thereafter	continued to report to a Division o	f Workforce

3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 11-10-507(b), concerning required work		
4	search contacts under the Division of Workforce Services Law, is amended to		
5	read as follows:		
6	(b)(1) Notwithstanding subdivision (a)(3) of this section, the		
7	division shall require at least five (5) work search contacts per week in		
8	which an individual submits a claim for benefits.		
9	(2)(A) The division shall match open jobs posted on the state-		
10	maintained job board with an individual submitting a claim for benefits if		
11	the job is available suitable work under § 11-10-515.		
12	(B) An individual matched with an open job under		
13	subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section shall apply to the suitable open job		
14	posted on the state-maintained job board that he or she is matched with as		
15	part of his or her work search contacts.		
16	(3) If an individual fails to complete the number of work search		
17	contacts required under subdivision (b)(l) of this section during a week in		
18	which he or she submits a claim for benefits, the individual is not eligible		
19	for benefits for that week.		
20	(3) (4) The division shall audit at least one hundred (100) of		
21	all weekly work search reports for work search verification and suitable work		
22	each week.
