6	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
7	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the sales tax holiday occurs		
8	the first weekend of August each year; that the Department of Finance and		
9	Administration must provide sellers at least sixty-days' notice of any		
10	changes to the sales tax holiday, which means the department must notify		
11	sellers by June 1, 2025, of the addition of firearm safety devices and		
12	firearm storage devices to the sales tax holiday; and that this act is		
13	immediately necessary because there is a mental health crisis in the state,		
14	and this act will help prevent tragic deaths in the state by incentivizing		
15	the purchase of firearm safety devices and firearm storage devices during the		
16	sales tax holiday. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act		
17	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health		
18	and safety shall become effective on:		
19	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
20	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
21	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
22	bill; or		
23	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
24	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
