35	Medicaid Program and the Arkansas Health and Opportunity for Me Program

2	(B) "Health benefit plan" includes indemnity and managed
3	care plans.
4	(C) "Health benefit plan" does not include:
5	(i) A plan that provides only dental benefits or eye
6	and vision care benefits;
7	(ii) A disability income plan;
8	(iii) A credit insurance plan;
9	(iv) Insurance coverage issued as a supplement to
10	liability insurance;
11	(v) A medical payment under an automobile or
12	homeowners insurance plan;
13	(vi) A health benefit plan provided under Arkansas
14	Constitution, Article 5, § 32, the Workers' Compensation Law, § 11-9-101 et
15	seq., or the Public Employee Workers' Compensation Act, § 21-5-601 et seq.;
16	(vii) A plan that provides only indemnity for
17	hospital confinement;
18	(viii) An accident-only plan;
19	(ix) A specified disease plan;
20	(x) A long-term-care-only plan; or
21	(xi) A plan providing health benefits to state and

23	(3)(A) "Healthcare insurer" means an entity subject to the
24	insurance laws of this state or the jurisdiction of the Insurance
25	Commissioner that contracts or offers to contract to provide health insurance
26	coverage, including without limitation an insurance company, a hospital and
27	medical service corporation, a health maintenance organization, a self-
28	insured governmental or church plan in this state, the Arkansas Medicaid
29	Program, and a nonprofit agricultural membership organization as defined in §
30	<u>23-60-104.</u>
31	(B) "Healthcare insurer" does not include an entity that
32	provides:
33	(i) Only dental benefits or eye and vision care
34	benefits; or
35	(ii) Health benefits to state and public school
36	employees under § 21-5-401 et seg.: and

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1	(4) "Licensed birthing center" means a birthing center licensed	
2	by the Department of Health that provides birthing services.

6	(a) On and after January 1, 2026, a health benefit plan that is	
7	offered, issued, renewed, delivered, or extended in this state shall provide	
8	the same coverage to an enrollee for birthing services received in a licensed	
9	birthing center as provided for birthing services received in a hospital.	
10	(b) The coverage for licensed birthing centers under subsection (a) of	
11	this section:	
12	(1) Is not subject to a greater deductible, coinsurance,	
13	copayment, or out-of-pocket limits than any other benefit provided by $\underline{a}$	
14	healthcare insurer under a health benefit plan; and	
15	(2) Does not diminish or limit benefits otherwise allowable	
16	under a health benefit plan.

19	(a) The Insurance Commissioner may develop and promulgate rules for	
20	the implementation and administration of this subchapter.	
21	(b) The Secretary of the Department of Human Services may develop and	
22	promulgate rules for the implementation and administration of this subchapter	
23	that apply to the Arkansas Medicaid Program or the Arkansas Health and	
24	Opportunity for Me Program established by the Arkansas Health and Opportunity	
25	for Me Act of 2021, § 23-61-1001 et seq.	
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
