36	to be seen by another person tha	at indicate entry or unauth	orized access is

1	forbidden without facility authorization:		
2	(A) A chemical or rubber manufacturing facility;		
3	(B) A water intake structure, water treatment facility,		
4	wastewater facility, drainage facility, water management facility, or any		
5	similar water or sewage treatment system and the water or sewage treatment		
6	system's piping;		
7	(C) A food processing or manufacturing facility;		
8	(D) A natural gas company facility, an underground gas		
9	storage facility, or interstate natural gas pipeline, including without		
10	limitation:		
11	(i) A pipeline interconnection;		
12	(ii) A natural gas compressor station and associated		
13	facility;		
14	(iii) A city gate or town border station;		
15	(iv) A metering station;		
16	(v) Aboveground piping;		
17	(vi) A regulator station;		
18	(vii) A valve site;		
19	(viii) A delivery station; and		
20	(ix) Fabricated assembly and any part of a natural		
21	gas storage facility involved in the gathering, storage, transmission, or		
22	distribution of gas;		
23	(E) Wireline or wireless telecommunications		
24	infrastructure, including telecommunications towers, telephone poles,		
25	telephone lines, and fiber optic lines;		
26	(F) A port, trucking terminal, or other freight		
27	transportation facility;		
28	(G) A gas processing plant, including a gas processing		
29	plant used in the processing, treatment, or fractionation of natural gas or		
30	natural gas liquids;		
31	(H) A crude oil or refined products storage and		
32	distribution facility, including without limitation:		
33	(i) A valve site;		
34	(ii) A pipeline interconnection;		
35	(iii) A pump station;		
36	(iv) A metering station;		

1	(v) A belowground or aboveground pipeline or piping;		
2	(vi) A truck loading or off-loading facility; and		
3	(vii) An aboveground portion of a well, well pad, or		
4	production operation;		
5	(I) A laydown area or construction site for pipe and other		
6	equipment intended for use on an interstate or intrastate natural gas or		
7	crude oil pipeline;		
8	(J) A portion of an oil, gas, hazardous liquid, or		
9	chemical pipeline, tank, or other storage facility that is aboveground;		
10	(K) A video service network and broadband infrastructure,		
11	including without limitation:		
12	(i) Associated buildings and facilities;		
13	(ii) Video service headends, towers, utility poles,		
14	and utility lines; and		
15	(iii) Fiber optic lines;		
16	(L) A mining operation, including any processing		
17	equipment, batching operation, or support facility for that mining operation;		
18	(M) A facility installed in a public right-of-way on a		
19	utility pole or in a conduit that is aboveground and concerns a video service		
20	network or broadband or wireless telecommunications infrastructure;		
21	(N) Railroad property; and		
22	(0) Property owned by and considered an electronic asset		
23	of any of the following:		
24	(i) An electric utility;		
25	(ii) An electric cooperative;		
26	(iii) A municipal electric utility;		
27	(iv) A natural gas company that is a public utility;		
28	(v) A telephone company that is a public utility; or		
29	(vi) A video service provider, including a cable		
30	operator; and
