8 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

9 TO PROVIDE FOR THE RECESS OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL
10 ASSEMBLY AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON APRIL 16, 2025;
11 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF
12 THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL 12:00 NOON,
13 MAY 5, 2025, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING VETOES,
14 CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, COMPLETING ITS WORK
15 ON PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS, AND
16 CONSIDERING THE NEED FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE
17 REGULAR SESSION OR TO ADJOURN THE NINETY-FIFTH
18 GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THAT DATE IF THEY
19 DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO NEED TO RECONVENE; AND TO
20 PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS NOT
21 RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE 12:00 NOON, MAY 5,
22 2025, THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL
23 ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED SINE DIE ON THAT DATE.

26 **Subtitle**

27 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE
28 REGULAR SESSION OF THE NINETY-FIFTH
29 GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND TO PROVIDE FOR A
30 RECESS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

32 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL
33 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

35 (a) That the Regular Session of the Ninety-Fifth General Assembly of
36 the State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 noon, May 5, 2025;



1 (b) That under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, prior to
2 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five (5) days
3 after receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill, therefore from April
4 16, 2025, to May 5, 2025, the House of Representatives and the Senate shall
5 be open so the office of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and
6 the office of the Secretary of the Senate may receive communications, vetoes
7 of bills by the Governor, and notification of errors and oversights;

8 (c) That the Regular Session of the Ninety-Fifth General Assembly of
9 the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess simultaneously at the close of
10 business in each chamber on April 16, 2025, or at such earlier time as may be
11 agreed upon by the House of Representatives and the Senate;

12 (d) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the
13 President Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation:

14 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00
15 noon, May 5, 2025, for the purpose of:

16 (A) Considering vetoes;

17 (B) Correcting errors and oversights;

18 (C) Completing its work on proposed constitutional
19 amendments; and

20 (D) Considering the need for further extension of the
21 Regular Session of the Ninety-Fifth General Assembly; or

22 (2) Adjourn the Regular Session of the Ninety-Fifth General
23 Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, May 5, 2025, if they determine it is
24 not necessary to reconvene; and

25 (e) That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned
26 before 12:00 noon, May 5, 2025, the Regular Session of the Ninety-Fifth
27 General Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date.
