12	Chamber of Commerce Member of the Year in 2003 and the Greene County									
13	Volunteer Attorney of the Year in 2011; and

16	baseball team and rarely missed an opportunity to support his Arkansas State									
17	Red Wolves in both basketball and football, and he also loved the University
