17	THE 2024 CLASS 2A STATE CHAMPIONS.

19	WHEREAS, the Yellville-Summit Panthers girl's track and field team won
20	the Class 2A State Track Meet held in Quitman on Tuesday, April 30, 2024; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, this was the fourth straight Class 2A state championship win
23	for the Panthers; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, the Panthers won these four (4) championships without having a
26	track and field facility, and they practice the track portion of the sport by
27	running at the Yellville City Park; and

29	WHEREAS, K.J. Moore led the team by either winning or sharing victory
30	in six (6) different events; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, K.J. Moore successfully defended her titles from the prior
33	year in the four-hundred-meter dash and the high jump; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, K.J. Moore also won the long jump, the one-hundred-meter
36	hurdles, and the two-hundred-meter dash; and

2	WHEREAS, K.J. Moore joined Bailey Ervin, Hannah Hayward, and Abby
3	Methvin in winning the four-by-four hundred meter relay, which was the second
4	straight title in this event for Moore, Ervin, and Methvin and the fourth
5	straight title in this event for Moore and Methvin; and

7	WHEREAS, the Panthers were also represented by Riley Hopson, who won
8	the eight-hundred-meter and sixteen-hundred-meter runs; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, the Panthers were also represented by Fay Chism, who placed
11	second in pole vault and fourth in the three-hundred-meter hurdles; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, the Panthers finished thirty-five (35) points ahead of the
14	runners-up from Gurdon; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, the Panthers were led by Head Coach April Martin, who was
17	named the Section 6 Girls' Outdoor Track and Field Coach of the Year by the
18	National Federation of State High School Associations and the 2024 Arkansas
19	Democrat-Gazette All-Arkansas Preps Girl's Track Coach of the Year; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, Head Coach April Martin stated, "We don't have the best
22	facilities, but that doesn't hold us back. We're going to work hard every day
23	that we can",

25	NOW THEREFORE,
26	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL
27	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

29	THAT the House of Representatives recognize the Yellville-Summit
30	Panthers girl's track and field team as the 2024 Class 2A state champions.
