16	WHEREAS, service to others is a hallmark of the American character and
17	has the unique ability to bring people of all backgrounds together in common
18	cause to meet the nation's most pressing challenges; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, thirty-one (31) years ago, Congress established AmeriCorps,
21	formerly the Corporation for National and Community Service, to unite
22	national service programs under one (1) agency, create service opportunities
23	that strengthen communities, and expand pathways to education, careers, and
24	civic participation for those who serve; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, AmeriCorps provides opportunities for two hundred thousand
27	(200,000) Americans each year to serve their country through an intensive
28	commitment to service at nonprofits, schools, public agencies, and community
29	and faith-based groups across the country; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, national service in AmeriCorps represents a robust public-
32	private partnership that invests in community solutions and leverages
33	nonfederal resources to strengthen community impact and increase the return
34	on taxpayer dollars, resulting in thirty seven million seven hundred thousand
35	dollars (\$37,700,000) in AmeriCorps education scholarships earned by
36	Arkansans since 1994; and

WHEREAS, in Arkansas, more than three thousand one hundred (3,100) AmeriCorps members and AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers of varying ages and backgrounds helped to meet local needs at more than three hundred (300) locations in the state by responding to disasters, mentoring children and youth, supporting veterans and military families, fighting the opioid epidemic, restoring the environment, addressing food insecurity, and helping secure jobs and housing; and

WHEREAS, AmeriCorps members and AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers encourage collaboration and partnerships, leveraging millions of volunteers in service and acquiring the support of businesses, foundations, and other local partners to increase the effectiveness of their initiatives; and

WHEREAS, AmeriCorps and AmeriCorps Seniors programs strengthen bridgebuilding skills by bringing people together from different backgrounds, generations, and geographic locations to address critical issues facing the country, forging relationships, cultivating mutual respect, and helping to build resilient and thriving communities; and

WHEREAS, volunteering prepares AmeriCorps members for future careers and improves the mental well-being of AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers, and their commitment to service reflects the dedication and patriotism of those who serve; and

35 WHEREAS, AmeriCorps Week is an opportunity to recognize the dedication 36 and commitment of two hundred thousand (200,000) AmeriCorps members and

AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers who serve each year and the more than one million three hundred thousand (1,300,000) AmeriCorps alumni and millions of AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers and their community partners, and to encourage more Americans to follow in their footsteps in service, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: THAT the House of Representatives recognize March 9-15, 2025, as AmeriCorps Week in Arkansas.
