21 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman, the longest-serving juvenile
22 judge serving Madison County and Washington County, Arkansas, has retired
23 after thirty-four (34) years of service; and

25 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman earned her Bachelor of Science
26 degree in Agricultural Economics from Texas Tech University in 1983,
27 graduating magna cum laude; and

29 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman earned her Doctor of
30 Jurisprudence with a Master of Science degree in Agricultural Economics from
31 Texas Tech University in 1986; and

33 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman earned her Master of Law degree
34 in Agricultural Law from the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville School of
35 Law in 1988; and

1 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman maintained a private law
2 practice in the City of Fayetteville from 1989, and was Deputy Prosecutor
3 with the Washington County Juvenile Court from 1993-1998; and

5 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman was appointed by then-Governor
6 Michael Dale "Mike" Huckabee to the Criminal Detention Facility Review
7 Committee and served as Special Judge for Benton County Juvenile Court; and

9 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman has served as volunteer
10 attorney ad litem for children in Madison County and Washington County; and

12 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman was elected as Circuit/Chancery
13 Judge, Juvenile Division, Fourth Judicial Circuit, Madison County and
14 Washington County, in November 1998; and

16 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman was named one of the Forty
17 Under Forty by Northwest Arkansas Business Journal in 1999 and is a member of
18 the Arkansas Bar Association and the State Bar of Texas as well as the Rotary
19 Club of Fayetteville; and

21 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman has served with the Arkansas
22 Bar Association's Juvenile Law Committee, is a past secretary/treasurer of
23 the Washington County Bar Association, is a past member of the Washington
24 County Juvenile Justice Advisory Board, and has participated in the National
25 Conference on Juvenile Justice; and

27 WHEREAS, the Honorable Stacey Zimmerman is married to Calvin W. Farley,
28 Vice President of Farley's, Incorporated of Siloam Springs, and they have one
29 (1) son, Colton,
