1	(44) "Central bank digital currency" means a digital currency, a		
2	digital medium of exchange, or a digital monetary unit of account issued by		
3	the Federal Reserve System, a federal agency, a foreign government, a foreig		
4	central bank, or a foreign reserve system that is made directly available to		
5	a consumer by such entities. "Central bank digital currency" includes a		
6	digital currency, a digital medium of exchange, or a digital monetary unit o		
7	account issued by the Federal Reserve System, a federal agency, a foreign		
8	government, a foreign central bank, or a foreign reserve system that is		
9	processed or validated directly by such entities.

11	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 4-9-102(29), concerning the Uniform		
12	Commercial Code - Secured Transactions definition of "deposit account", is		
13	amended to read as follows:		
14	(29) "Deposit account" means a demand, time, savings, passbook,		
15	or similar account maintained with a bank. The term "deposit account" does		
16	not include investment property, central bank digital currency, or accounts		
17	evidenced by an instrument.
