24	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Title. This act shall be known and may</u>	<u>be</u>
25	cited as "Lux's Law".

27	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 17, Subchapter 1, is	
28	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:	
29	20-17-108. Sale of dead human bodies or parts — Prohibited — Penalt	<u>y.</u>
30	(a) It is unlawful for a person to sell a dead human body or parts	<u>of</u>
31	a dead human body that has been authorized for final disposition through	
32	cremation.	
33	(b) An individual who violates this section may be punished by a fi	<u>ne</u>
34	of not more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or by imprisonment for not	
35	more than five (5) years, or both.	
36	(c) An offense under this section is a strict liability offense.
