24	(a) Customers of a	a public water system shall have t	the option to hold

28	(b)(l) An election	n under this section may be called	i by:
29	<u>(A) A</u>	petition for each county supplied	l by the public
30	water system signed by no	o less than five percent (5%) of t	the total number of
31	votes cast within the co	unty for the office of county judg	ge in the last
32	election; or		
33	<u>(B) A</u>	majority vote of the quorum court	of a county
34	supplied by the public wa	ater system.	
35	(2)(A) Excep	ot as provided under subdivision ((b)(2)(B) of this
36	section, an election unde	er this section shall be held at t	the next general

1	election.		
2	(B) A subsequent election in the public water system under		
3	this section shall not be held earlier than four (4) years after an election		
4	is held under this section.		
5	(3) Except as provided in this section, the election under this		
6	section shall be held and conducted in accordance with the general election		
7	laws of this state.		
8	(4) The question of whether to fluoridate the water in the		
9	public water system shall be placed upon the ballots of the qualified		
10	electors in the following form:		
11	FOR THE FLUORIDATION OF WATER IN [DESCRIPTION OF THE		
12	PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM]		
13	AGAINST THE FLUORIDATION OF WATER IN [DESCRIPTION OF		
14	PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM].".		
15	(c)(1) The petition under this section shall be filed with the county		
16	clerk of the county where the sponsor of the petition resides no less than		
17	one hundred twenty (120) days before the general election.		
18	(2) No more than ten (10) days after the filing of the petition		
19	under subdivision (c)(1) of this section, the county clerk shall:		
20	(A) Verify the petition;		
21	(B) Certify the petition; and		
22	(C) Notify the county boards of election commissioners for		
23	the counties within the public water system and the board of directors of the		
24	public water system of the verification and certification of the petition.		
25	(3) The petition shall clearly state:		
26	(A) The boundaries of the public water system; and		
27	(B) That the petition is to elect "for" or "against"		
28	fluoridation of the water in the public water system.		
29	(d) If the petition is sufficient, the question of whether to		
30	fluoridate the water in the public water system shall be placed on the ballot		
31	in each county supplied by the public water system.		
32	(e) If the majority of the qualified electors of the majority of the		
33	counties supplied by the public water system elect to prohibit fluoridation		
34	of water, the public water system shall cease fluoridation of the water		
35	within thirty (30) days of the certification of the election results.		
36	(f) As used in this section, "public water system" means a facility,		

1	including without limitation a parent system, consecutive system, or other		
2	system, that holds, treats, and supplies water directly or through a		
3	consecutive system or consecutive systems to five thousand (5,000) persons of		
4	more.		
5			
6	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-7-136(b), concerning a statewide		
7	fluoridation program, is amended to read as follows:		
8	(b) (1) The Except as provided in subdivision (b) (2) of this section,		
9	the company, corporation, municipality, county, government agency, or other		
10	entity that owns or controls a water system shall control the quantity of		
11	fluoride in the water so as to maintain a fluoride content established by the		
12	Department of Health.		
13	(2)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(2)(B) of this		
14	section, the board of a public water system may elect to prohibit		
15	fluoridation of the water it supplies.		
16	(B) The results of an election under § 14-16-108 shall		
17	supersede any decision of the board of a public water system regarding the		
18	fluoridation of the water it supplies.
