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31	SECTION 2. Arkansas	Code Title 23, Chapter 12, S	ubchapter 5, is	
32	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:			
33	23-12-515. Railroad fatality reports.			
34	(a)(l) Except as pr	(a)(1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a report		
35	involving a railroad fatality and all communications between police officers			
36	and railroad crew members involved in a railroad fatality shall be maintained			

1	in a manner that ensures the confidentiality of the personal information of		
2	the railroad crew involved in the fatality.		
3	(2) If information under subdivision (a)(1) of this section is		
4	publicly disclosed, the personal information of the railroad crew shall be		
5	redacted from the information.		
6	(b)(1) Subsection (a) of this section does not apply if the requestor		
7	<u>is:</u>		
8	(A) The host or employing railroad;		
9	(B) A person authorized by court order to obtain the		
10	information under subsection (a) of this section;		
11	(C) A law enforcement officer;		
12	(D) An attorney for the State of Arkansas;		
13	(E) A staff member of the Arkansas Department of		
14	<u>Transportation</u> ; or		
15	(F) The Federal Railroad Administration or the United		
16	States Surface Transportation Board if one or both have determined that a		
17	violation of a Department of Transportation regulation or crew negligence was		
18	the cause of the railroad fatality.		
19	(2) A request under subdivision (b)(1) of this section shall be		
20	made in written or electronic form.		
21	(3) A person identified under subdivisions (b)(1)(B)-(E) of this		
22	section shall only obtain information under subsection (a) of this section if		
23	access to the information is necessary for the performance of his or her		
24	<u>duties.</u>		
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
