21	SECTION 1. Ar	kansas Code Title 14, Chapter 116, Subchapte	er l, is
22	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

24	(a) Customers	of a public water system shall have the opt	tion to hold
25	an election of the q	ualified electors of the public water system	n to determine
26	whether or not the p	ublic water system shall fluoridate the wate	er.
27	(b)(1) An ele	ction under this section may be called by:	
28	<u>(A)</u>) Majority vote of the board of directors of	of the public
29	water system;		
30	<u>(B</u>) A petition signed by no less than ten per	rcent (10%) of
31	the qualified electo	rs in the public water system;	
32	<u>(C</u>) Majority vote of the board of directors of	or city
33	council of a city supplied by the public water system; or		
34	<u>(D</u>) Majority vote of the quorum court of a co	ounty supplied
35	by the public water system.		
36	<u>(2)(A)</u>	Except as provided under subdivision (b)(2)	(B) of this

1	ection, an election under this section shall be held at the next general		
2	election.		
3	(B) A subsequent election in the public water system under		
4	this section shall not be held earlier than four (4) years after an election		
5	is held under this section.		
6	(3) Except as provided in this section, the election under this		
7	section shall be held and conducted in accordance with the general election		
8	laws of this state.		
9	(4) The question of whether to fluoridate the water in the		
10	public water system shall be placed upon the ballots of the qualified		
11	electors in the following form:		
12	" FOR THE FLUORIDATION OF WATER IN [DESCRIPTION OF THE		
13	PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM]		
14	AGAINST THE FLUORIDATION OF WATER IN [DESCRIPTION OF		
15	PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM].".		
16	(c)(1) The petition under this section shall be filed with the county		
17	clerk of each county within the public water system no less than one hundred		
18	twenty (120) days before the general election.		
19	(2) No more than ten (10) days after the filing of the petition		
20	under subdivision (c)(1) of this section, the county clerk shall:		
21	(A) Verify the petition;		
22	(B) Certify the petition; and		
23	(C) Notify the county boards of election commissioners for		
24	the counties within the public water system and the board of directors of the		
25	public water system of the verification and certification of the petition.		
26	(3) The petition shall clearly state:		
27	(A) The boundaries of the public water system; and		
28	(B) That the petition is to elect "for" or "against"		
29	fluoridation of the water in the public water system.		
30	(d) If the majority of the qualified electors of the public water		
31	system elect to prohibit fluoridation of water, the public water system shall		
32	cease fluoridation of the water within thirty (30) days of the certification		
33	of the election results.		
34	(e) As used in this section, "public water system" means a facility,		
35	including without limitation a parent system, consecutive system, or other		
36	everam that holds treats and sumplies water directly or through a		

1	consecutive system or consecutive systems to five thousand (5,000) persons or		
2	more.

4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-7-136(b), concerning a statewide		
5	fluoridation program, is amended to read as follows:		
6	(b) The Unless a majority of the qualified electors of the public		
7	water system have elected to prohibit fluoridation of water under § 14-116-		
8	108, the company, corporation, municipality, county, government agency, or		
9	other entity that owns or controls a water system shall control the quantity		
10	of fluoride in the water so as to maintain a fluoride content established by		
11	the Department of Health.
