5	(3) Any agricultural purposes, including any form of cultivatio		
6	for agricultural purposes, digging for postholes on private property,		
7	construction and maintenance of farm ponds, land clearing, or other normal		
8	agricultural purposes that are not on a right-of-way of an operator;		
9	(4) The opening of a grave in a cemetery that is not on a right		
10	of-way of an operator; or		
11	(5) Routine road work and general maintenance as performed in		
12	the right-of-way by state or county maintenance departments, but excluding		
13	any work or maintenance involving any demolition or excavation.
