12	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED	INTO THE ARKANSAS
13	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORA	ARY LAW.
14	TRANSFER PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chie	ef Fiscal Officer
15	of the State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative	Council or Joint
16	Budget Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appr	ropriation from any
17	line item authorized in Operations Appropriation of the Gov	vernor's Office in
18	this Act to any other line item authorized in Operations Ap	opropriation.
19	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only f	from July 1, <del>2024</del>
20	2025 through June 30, 2025 2026.

22	SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement	of funds
23	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation	on for such agency
24	and funds made available by law for the support of such app	propriations; and
25	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General	Accounting and
26	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, th	ne Regular Salary
27	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and o	other fiscal
28	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulation	ons promulgated by
29	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized	d by law, shall be
30	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

32	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of t	che General
33	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the	ne appropriations
34	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the state	ed reasons for
35	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requ	uests, Executive
36	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in	in the budget

1	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or	
2	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative	
3	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.	
4		
5	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General	
6	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the	
7	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the	
8	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to the operation of	
9	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in	
10	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the	
11	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2025 could work irreparable harm	
12	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental	
13	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act	
14	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health	
15	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2025.	
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
