(44) "Central bank digital currency" means a digital currency, a digital medium of exchange, or a digital monetary unit of account issued by the Federal Reserve System, a federal agency, a foreign government, a foreign central bank, or a foreign reserve system that is made directly available to a consumer by such entities. "Central bank digital currency" includes a digital currency, a digital medium of exchange, or a digital monetary unit of account issued by the Federal Reserve System, a federal agency, a foreign government, a foreign central bank, or a foreign reserve system, that is processed or validated directly by such entities. SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 4-9-102(29), concerning the Uniform Commercial Code - Secured Transactions definition of "deposit account", is amended to read as follows: (29) "Deposit account" means a demand, time, savings, passbook, or similar account maintained with a bank. The term "deposit account" does not include investment property, central bank digital currency, or accounts evidenced by an instrument.
