21	TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF DISPOSABLE VAPOR

25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-57-203, concerning definitions with	hin
28	the Arkansas Tobacco Products Tax Act of 1977, is amended to add additi	onal
29	subdivisions to read as follows:	
30	(38) "Disposable vapor product" means a vapor product that	<u>:</u>
31	(A) Has a battery that is not detachable from the at	<u>omizer</u>
32	or vaporizer;	
33	(B) Cannot be refilled with e-liquid; and	
34	(C) Is designed to be disposed of after the e-liquid	<u>is</u>
35	used; and	
36	(39) "Prohibited foreign party" means the same as in § 18-	11-

3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 26, Chapter 57, Subchapter 2, is
4	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
5	26-57-269. Prohibition on sale of disposable vapor product.
6	(a) A person or entity shall not sell or offer for sale at retail in
7	this state a disposable vapor product from a prohibited foreign party.
8	(b)(1) The Director of Arkansas Tobacco Control may seize and hold for
9	disposition of the courts or the Arkansas Tobacco Control Board any
10	disposable vapor product sold or offered for sale in violation of this
11	section.
12	(2) The processes of seizure, forfeiture, and disposition under
13	§ 26-57-247 and the destruction of the seized products under § 26-57-249
14	shall apply to this section.
15	(c) A violation of subsection (a) of this section is a Class A
16	misdemeanor.
17	(d) This section does not apply to a product that has been approved by
18	the United States Food and Drug Administration.
19	
20	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. Notice of act
21	requirements and allowance of a grace period.
22	The Director of Arkansas Tobacco Control shall notify manufacturers,
23	wholesalers, retailers, and vendors licensed under § 26-57-219 of:
24	(1) The requirements of this act and the time frame in which
25	compliance is required; and
26	(2) The allowance of a ninety-day grace period following the
27	effective date of this act during which any disposal vapor product from a
28	prohibited foreign party in their possession shall be liquidated, sold, or
29	disposed of.
