28	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Applicability</u> .		
29	(a) The Oil and Gas Commission shall not issue a permit to a digital		
30	asset mining business that plans to operate at a location within a thirty-		
31	mile radius of a military facility on or after the effective date of this		
32	act.		
33	(b) If the commission has already issued a permit to a digital asset		
34	mining business that has a location that is within a thirty-mile radius of a		
35	military facility before the effective date of this act, the commission shall		
36	revoke the permit unless the digital asset mining facility shuts down

1	operations or construction at the location that is within a thirty-mile			
2	radius of a military facility.

4	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the			
5	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that digital asset mining, also			
6	known as "cryptomining", is a rising industry in the state that poses unique			
7	opportunities as well as risks; that risks posed by digital asset mining			
8	include without limitation threats to national security and the security of			
9	the State of Arkansas; that threats to national security and the security of			
10	the State of Arkansas are amplified by a digital asset mining facility's			
11	being located within a thirty-mile radius of a military facility; that there			
12	are military facilities located in many different areas of the State of			
13	Arkansas; and that this act is immediately necessary in order to ensure the			
14	health and safety of the State of Arkansas and its citizens. Therefore, an			
15	emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for			
16	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become			
17	effective on:			
18	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;			
19	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,			
20	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the			
21	bill; or			
22	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is			
23	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
