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33	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAI	USE. It is found and determined by the	
34	General Assembly of the State of	Arkansas that the General Assembly passed	
35	Acts 2025, No. 373, to allow for significant investment in electric public		
36	utility infrastructure and natural gas public utility infrastructure to		

1	enable this state to attract and serve economic development projects across a	
2	variety of industries, as well as to continue reliably supporting existing	
3	and new customers; that an engrossing error was discovered during the review	
4	of Acts 2025, No. 373; and that this act is immediately necessary to correct	
5	the engrossing error found during the review of Acts 2025, No. 373.	
6	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately	
7	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall	
8	become effective on:	
9	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;	
10	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,	
11	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the	
12	bill; or	
13	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is	
14	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.	
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
