21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code	\$25-19-106, as amended by S	B227 of 2025, is
22	amended to add an additional su	bsection to read as follows:	
23	(j)(l) Notwithstanding a	ny provision to the contrary,	if a circuit
24	court finds that a governing bo	<u>dy or a member of a governing</u>	body violated
25	this section concerning the iss	uance of bonds, the circuit c	ourt may only
26	invalidate the action by the go	verning body authorizing the	issuance of bonds
27	within thirty (30) days of the	date the action occurred.	
28	(2) If a circuit c	ourt makes a finding describe	<u>d under</u>
29	subdivision (j)(l) of this sect	ion more than thirty (30) day	s after the
30	action by the governing body au	thorizing the issuance of the	bonds:
31	(A) The gove	rning body shall cure the vio	lation within

7	(ii) If the public entity is not subject to damages		
8	because of sovereign immunity, then the Arkansas State Claims Commission		
9	shall have jurisdiction under § 19-10-201 et seq. over all claims made for		
10	the recovery of the fine available under subdivision (j)(2)(B)(i) of this		
11	section.		
12	(3) The remedies under subdivision (j)(2) of this section are		
13	supplemental to all other remedies available under this chapter within the		
14	applicable statute of limitations.		
15	(4) As used in this subsection, "bonds" means bonds and other		
16	debt-related instruments, including without limitation a short-term financing		
17	obligation, under Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 78.

19	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Contingency.</u>		
20	(a) Section 1 of this act shall become effective only if SB227 of the		
21	Ninety-Fifth General Assembly is enacted by the General Assembly and becomes		
22	an act.		
23	(b) If SB227 of the Ninety-Fifth General Assembly does not become an		
24	act, Section 1 of this act shall not become effective.
