12	SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement	of funds	
13	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriatio	n for such agency	
14	and funds made available by law for the support of such app	ropriations; and	
15	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General	Accounting and	
16	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, th	e Regular Salary	
17	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and o	ther fiscal	
18	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulatio	ns promulgated by	
19	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be		
20	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

22	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of t	he General	
23	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of th	e appropriations	
24	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the state	d reasons for	
25	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive		
26	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget		
27	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or		
28	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative		
29	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passa	ge and adoption.	
30			
31	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determi	ned by the General	
32	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
33	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period;	that the	
34	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to t	<u>he operation of</u>	
35	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in		

the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

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1	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm
2	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
3	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
4	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
5	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2025.
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
