21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 23, Subchapter 1, is	
22	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:	
23	15-23-107. Prohibition on moratorium in watersheds and other bodies	s of
24	water.	
25	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a state	
26	agency, including without limitation the Department of Agriculture and the	<u>e</u>
27	Department of Energy and Environment, shall not institute a moratorium on	<u>the</u>
28	issuance of permits in a watershed, including without limitation the Buffa	<u>alo</u>
29	River Watershed, or other body of water.	
30	(b) If a state agency wishes to institute a moratorium related to a	<u>a</u>
31	watershed or other body of water, the state agency first shall obtain	
32	approval from the Legislative Council.
