APPROPRIATION - NORTHWEST TECHNICAL INSTITUTE - CASH. 7 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be payable 8 from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code §19-4-801, for personal services 9 and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Division of Higher 10 Education - Northwest Technical Institute - Cash for the fiscal year ending 11 June 30, 2026, the following:

27 SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DHE - REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES FOR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION. Upon 29 30 determination by the president or chancellor of an institution of higher 31 education that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or 32 consolidation of administrative functions within the institution is necessary 33 for efficient and effective operations of the institution, the president or 34 chancellor, with approval of the institution's board of trustees, may have 35 the authority to transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between 36 campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the institution,

1 after receiving prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 2 Committee. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used 3 for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General 4 Assembly. The transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations which involve 5 academic programs shall be reviewed by the Division of Higher Education prior 6 to submission to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Provided, 7 however, that the institution shall be limited to submitting no more than two 8 (2) individual transaction transfer requests during any fiscal year and shall 9 be further limited to no more than five percent (5%) of the total General 10 Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation, funding, positions specific to 11 each institution, and no Tobacco Settlement funds or appropriations may be 12 reallocated pursuant to this section.

13 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 14 appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher 15 education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This 16 is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation 17 act(s) for institutions of higher education and the general revenue 18 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the 19 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that 20 institutions of higher education may operate more efficiently if some 21 flexibility is provided to institutions of higher education authorizing broad 22 powers under this section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate 23 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of 24 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this 25 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement 26 27 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled 28 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 29 void.

 DHE - BUILDING MAINTENANCE FUND. After the sum of \$13,200,000 has been
 deposited into the Higher Education Building Maintenance Fund, any additional

1 deposits are to be transferred to the Research Development Fund there to be 2 used as provided by law.

6 SECTION 32. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 8 DHE - TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon certification by the Director of the Division 9 of Higher Education that transfers are needed to make maximum utilization of 10 funds and appropriations provided for financial aid programs, and with the 11 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and a review by the 12 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, funds and 13 appropriations may be transferred between financial aid programs to more 14 adequately align the appropriation with the number of eligible students. 15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2024 16 2025 through June 30, 2025 2026.

18 SECTION 33. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 20 DHE - TRANSFER OF HIGHER EDUCATION GRANTS FUND APPROPRIATIONS - HEALTH 21 EDUCATION GRANTS AND LOANS. Upon certification to and with the approval of 22 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, surplus funds and appropriations may 23 be transferred between the appropriations provided for "Health Education 24 Grants and Loans" by this Act by the General Assembly for Dental Aid Grants 25 and Loans, Optometry Aid Grants and Loans, Veterinary Aid, Veterinary Med. Loan Forgiveness Program, Podiatry Aid, and Chiropractic Aid. 26

30 SECTION 34. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 32 DHE - CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATIONS - TRANSFERS AND REPORTS. (a) Upon approval 33 by the Department of Education - Division of Higher Education and the Chief 34 Fiscal Officer of the State, institutions of higher education may transfer 35 appropriation from the cash contingency appropriation to any other 36 appropriation made to the institution from cash funds including the

1 establishment of commitment items, and may transfer appropriation from the 2 contingency appropriation made payable from each institution's State Treasury 3 Fund to the state operations appropriation made payable from each 4 institution's State Treasury Fund including the establishment of commitment 5 items, and may transfer appropriation from the contingency appropriation made 6 payable from the Tobacco Settlement Program Fund Accounts to any other 7 appropriation made to the institution from Tobacco Settlement Program Fund 8 Accounts including the establishment of commitment items.

9 (b) Contingency appropriation transfers shall only establish and 10 supplement commitment items that were recommended by the Higher Education 11 Coordinating Board in the budget manuals presented to the Legislative Council 12 and Joint Budget Committee.

13 (c) The Department of Education - Division of Higher Education shall 14 report contingency appropriation transfers and the establishment of any 15 commitment items authorized by this Section to the Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee for review during its July meeting. The report shall 17 include, by institution, the establishment of, and the amounts transferred 18 to, each commitment item, the reasons therefor and the source of funds. 19 Institutions shall submit contingency appropriation transfer and commitment 20 item establishment requests authorized by this Section to the Division of 21 Higher Education no later than July 1. Upon the failure of an institution to 22 submit the required information by the July 1 deadline, the Department of 23 Education - Division of Higher Education shall immediately notify by written 24 notification the chairpersons of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 25 Committee.

SECTION 35. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 29 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 31 DHE WORKFORCE INITIATIVE ACT FUNDING. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State 32 may transfer, on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the 33 Auditor of the State, funding up to the amount authorized in the Workforce 34 Initiative Act of 2015 appropriation section in this Act, from the Division 35 of Higher Education Fund Account to the Workforce Initiative Act of 2015 Fund 36 in order to finance the distribution of grants identified under §6-60-107.

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The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2024

SECTION 36. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 6 DHE - STATEWIDE SCHOLARSHIP AND GRANT PROMOTION. Of the general revenue that 7 is received by and distributed from the Higher Education Grants Fund Account, 8 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer two hundred ninety-five 9 thousand dollars (\$295,000) to the Division of Higher Education Fund Account 10 to be allocated, budgeted, committed and distributed to the Statewide 11 Scholarship and Grant Promotion line item in the General Operations section 12 of this Act for the purpose of increasing public awareness of the 13 scholarships and grants offered by the State through the Arkansas Department 14 of Education - Division of Higher Education. The Department shall utilize a 15 minimum of one hundred forty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$147,500) 16 of the aforementioned total specifically for the promotion of the Arkansas 17 Future Grant Program.

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21 SECTION 37. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 23 GOVERNOR'S HIGHER EDUCATION TRANSITION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM. The Department 24 of Education - Division of Higher Education shall provide for the 25 administration of the "Governor's Higher Education Transition Scholarship 26 Program" as appropriated in the Student Assistance Grants and Various 27 Scholarships Appropriation section of this Act to assist students accepted 28 into transitional programs for students with intellectual and/or 29 developmental disabilities at state institutions of higher education and 30 shall promulgate rules for the implementation of the program and for the 31 disbursement of scholarships to eligible students.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2024}{2025}$ through June 30, $\frac{2025}{2026}$.

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35 SECTION 38. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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9 SECTION 39. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 12 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17

18 SECTION 40. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 19 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 20 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to the operation of 21 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2025 could work irreparable harm 24 25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2025. 28 29 30 /s/Joint Budget Committee 31 32 33

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
