17	WHEREAS, the future of the State of Arkansas is dependent to a large
18	extent on the good health of its families; and

20	WHEREAS, good health can be achieved in part through good dental habits
21	learned early and reinforced throughout life; and

23	WHEREAS, research shows that a balanced diet, proper oral hygiene, and
24	preventative dental care can prevent tooth decay and reduce dental-related
25 26	illnesses that cause school-aged children in the United States to miss thirty-four million (34,000,000) school hours annually, starting as early as
20	grade one (1), lost hours that exacerbate socioeconomic disparities; and
