20	WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., is a collegiate Greek-letter
21	fraternity founded on January 5, 1911, at Indiana University in Bloomington;
22	and
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24	WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., has over one hundred fifty
25	thousand (150,000) members in seven hundred (700) undergraduate and alumni
26	chapters in every state of the United States and around the world; and
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28	WHEREAS, the members of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., are risk
29	takers, trailblazers, and changemakers with a passion for achievement in
30	every field of human endeavor, uplifting their communities, and developing
31	the current and next generation of leaders; and
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33	WHEREAS, at the time of the founding of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity,
34	Inc., in Bloomington, Indiana, Indiana was a stronghold for the Ku Klux Klan,
35	but despite the hostility toward Blacks in Indiana, some Black students
36	sought a college education at Indiana University as it was a tuition-free



1	university of the highest quality; and
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3	WHEREAS, during the 1910-1911 school year, a small group of Black
4	students at Indiana University, realizing that they had no part in the
5	university's social life, decided that a Greek-letter fraternity would do
6	much to fill the missing link in their college existence, particularly as two
7	(2) members of this group had previously attended Howard University in
8	Washington, D.C., home of the only national historically Black Greek-letter
9	fraternity then in existence; and
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11	WHEREAS, the founding members of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., were
12	God-fearing and serious-minded young men with the imagination, ambition,
13	courage, and determination to defy custom in pursuit of a college education
14	and career, and they decided that their fraternity would be more than a
15	social organization, and would instead be founded upon the concept of
16	achievement; and
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18	WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., is the second-oldest
19	existing collegiate historically Black Greek-letter fraternity, and its
20	members are proud that its Constitution has never contained any clause that
21	excludes a man from membership because of his color, creed, or national
22	origin; and
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24	WHEREAS, local chapters of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.,
25	participate in community outreach activities to feed the homeless, provide
26	scholarships to young people matriculating to college, serve as mentors to
27	young men, participate in blood drives, and serve as hosts of seminars for
28	public health awareness, and the fraternity has also provided summer
29	enrichment camps and over one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in funds for St.
30	Jude Children's Research Hospital; and
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32	WHEREAS, members of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., have also
33	answered the call to service by proudly serving in the United States Armed
34	Forces since World War I and raising funds to assist those in need following
35	natural disasters worldwide; and

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1	WHEREAS, famed members of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., include
2	Wilt Chamberlain, Cedric the Entertainer, Arthur Ashe, Johnnie Cochran, John
3	Conyers, Kwame Jackson, Bill Russell, Tavis Smiley, and Colin Kaepernick,
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5	NOW THEREFORE,
6	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
7	STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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9	THAT the Senate recognize Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., for its
10	positive impact upon its communities, the State of Arkansas, the nation, and
11	the world.
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13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon adoption, a copy of this resolution be
14	presented to the leadership of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., by the
15	Secretary of the Senate.
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
