9 CONGRATULATING THE ROLLIN' RAZORBACKS FOR WINNING
10 THEIR SIXTH DIVISION II NATIONAL WHEELCHAIR
11 BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP.

15 CONGRATULATING THE ROLLIN' RAZORBACKS
16 FOR WINNING THEIR SIXTH DIVISION II
17 NATIONAL WHEELCHAIR BASKETBALL
18 CHAMPIONSHIP.

20 WHEREAS, the Rollin' Razorbacks from Sherwood, Arkansas, won the
21 Division II National Wheelchair Basketball Championship Game on March 29,
22 2026, in West Monroe, Louisiana, defeating the Memorial Rehabilitation Sharks
23 from Fort Lauderdale, Florida, with a final score of 61-51; and

24
25 WHEREAS, the March 29, 2026, championship win marked the sixth national
26 championship title in the program's history and the first national
27 championship title in twenty-six (26) years; and

28
29 WHEREAS, the Rollin' Razorbacks ended their 2025-2026 regular season
30 with fifteen wins, four losses, and zero ties (15-4-0), going into the
31 Division II National Wheelchair Basketball Championship tournament as the
32 number two (2) seed; and

34 WHEREAS, the Rollin' Razorbacks were led to victory by head coach Jared
35 Johnson and assistant coaches Bob Haugen and Jason Monroe, along with staff
36 members Carla Haugen and Curtis Thompkins; and

2 WHEREAS, the Rollin' Razorbacks sought and achieved a national
3 championship under players Denis Kraev, Jeff Glasbrenner, Tim Eldridge,
4 Anthonee Tate, Michael Thompkins, Mark Richey, Jwan Pickens, and David Satre;

7 WHEREAS, Jeff Glasbrenner was named the Most Valuable Player of the
8 game with a total of twenty-four (24) points, sixteen (16) rebounds, and five
9 (5) assists; and

11 WHEREAS, the Rollin' Razorbacks competed in the 2026 Adult Division II
12 National Wheelchair Basketball Championship March 26-29, 2026, which featured
13 a sixteen-team tournament format in three (3) adult divisions with a total of
14 forty-five (45) teams and more than five hundred (500) athletes from across
15 the United States; and

17 WHEREAS, the Rollin' Razorbacks defeated the Charlotte Rollin' Hornets
18 with a score of 70-44 in the first round of the tournament, the Naval Medical
19 Center San Diego Wolf Pack with a score of 62-20 in the quarter-final round
20 of the tournament, and the Ability360 Phoenix Wheelchair Suns with a score of
21 57-56 in the final seconds of the semi-final round of the tournament; and

23 WHEREAS, when interviewed following the championship win, Coach Jared
24 Johnson remarked on his coaching role, which requires a coach to "prepare
25 your players for ... adversity so they are ready to overcome those moments
26 that are really hard",

28 NOW THEREFORE,

29 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL
30 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

32 THAT the House of Representatives congratulate the Rollin' Razorbacks
33 for their national championship win.

35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon its adoption, a copy of this resolution be
36 presented to the Rollin' Razorbacks Head Coach, Jared Johnson, by the Chief
