24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
27 for the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council for the  
28 2026-2027 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

1 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for  
 2 the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council for the 2026-  
 3 2027 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
 4 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated  
 5 herein for such purposes: thirty-one (31) temporary or part-time employees,  
 6 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform  
 7 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
 8 appropriate classification.

 10 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 11 to the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council, to be  
 12 payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services,  
 13 operating expenses, contingency, committee rooms, and construction and  
 14 capital improvements of the Bureau of Legislative Research and the  
 15 Legislative Council for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, the following:

 8 appropriated, to the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative  
 9 Council Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the State Central Services  
 10 Fund, for paying per diem, expenses and mileage to members of the Arkansas  
 11 General Assembly attending regular and special meetings and other committee  
 12 related activities of the Committees of the Arkansas General Assembly for the  
 13 fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, the following:

 21 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
 23 CLASSIFICATION UTILIZATION. The Bureau of Legislative Research may utilize,  
 24 at the discretion of the Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research, the  
 25 following classifications as necessary. The use of these classifications  
 26 shall not be considered as increasing the number of positions authorized in  
 27 this act, only as a temporary reclassification or cross grade of a position.

27       The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2025~~  
28 2026 through June 30, ~~2026~~ 2027.

30       SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
31 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
32 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
33 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

3  
4 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
5 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
6 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
7 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
8 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
9 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
10 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
11 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

12  
13 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
14 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
15 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2026 is essential to the operation of  
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
18 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
19 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2026 could work irreparable harm  
20 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
21 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
22 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
23 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2026.
