30 atop power lines twenty-four (24) hours a day, three hundred sixty-five (365)
31 days a year, to keep electricity flowing; and

33 WHEREAS, lineworkers often work under dangerous conditions away from
34 their families to construct and maintain the energy infrastructure of this
35 state; and

1 WHEREAS, lineworkers put their lives on the line every day with little
2 recognition from the community regarding the danger of their work; and

4 WHEREAS, it is most fitting and proper that the lineworkers of Arkansas
5 be recognized for their effective and dedicated service to the people of the
6 State of Arkansas,

8 NOW THEREFORE,
9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
10 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13 Appreciation Day at the State Capitol and commend, on behalf of their
