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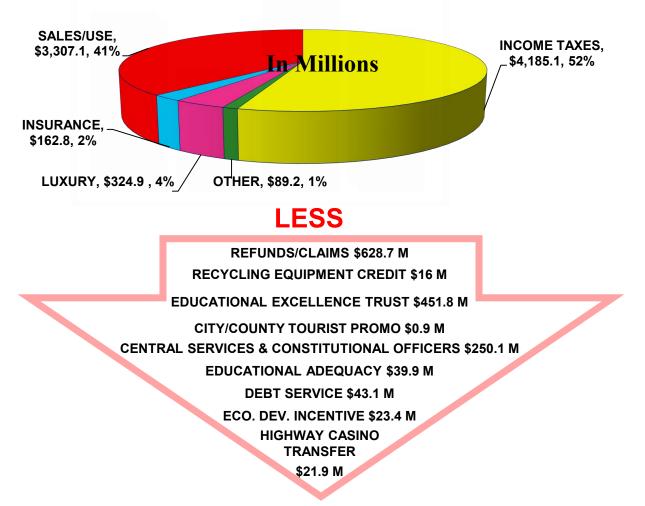

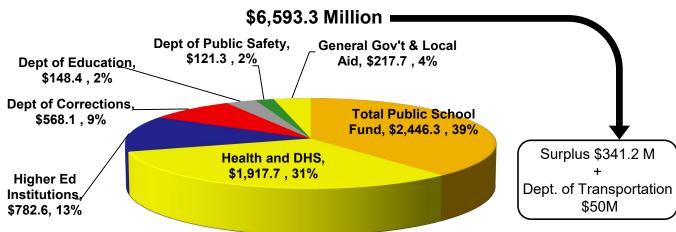
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FY2023-24 ESTIMATED GROSS GENERAL REVENUES

Act 888 of 2023 Revenue Stabilization Act

Fiscal Year 2024 allocations in the Revenue Stabilization Act to distribute General Revenue to State Agencies, Departments, Institutions of Higher Education, General Government and Local Support total \$6.2 billion dollars, which is an increase of 2.95% over the previous 10 fiscal year.

Some of the Significant Change Levels to the FY2024 State General Revenue Budget are:

- The Public School Fund and Department of Education allocations total \$2.5 billion do1llars, with increases of \$150 million dollars to provide general support for School Districts and funding for the LEARNS Act. Additional funding for K-12 Education is also provided through Set-Asides in Act 561 which provide \$136.2 million dollars for various educational purposes and \$512 million dollars for Educational Facilities.
- The Career and Technical Education allocation of \$8.4 million dollars was increased by \$350,000 dollars for additional grants to Literacy Councils.
- The Department of Human Services (DHS) allocations total \$1.8 billion dollars, with increases of \$6.6 million for the foster care program and \$2.25 million for the County Jail Mental Health Pilot Program.
- The Department of Corrections allocations total \$542 million dollars, with increases of \$40 million dollars, for staffing and Health Insurance and \$750,000 for Drug Task Force increased funding. This does not include \$25.7 million dollars allocated for County Jail Reimbursement.
- The Department of the Military allocation totals \$9.99 million dollars, with increases of over \$2 million dollars for personnel changes, increased utility costs, and various renovations and upgrades.
- The Arkansas State Police allocation total is \$88.7 million dollars, with a \$6.3 million dollar increase for positions, overtime, increased operating expenses, and troop school costs.
- The Institutions of Higher Education total allocation for all Institutions and Colleges total \$782.6 million or 12.62% of the general revenue funding available. This includes an increase of \$5 million dollars to UAMS for general operating expenses.

FUNDING FOR ACT 237 - THE LEARNS ACT

The total estimated cost for the LEARNS Act is \$297.5 million dollars for Fiscal Year 2024 and \$343.3 million dollars for Fiscal Year 2025. Funding for Fiscal Year 2024 is provided for with a \$150 million dollar increase (for general adequacy and LEARNS Act) in the Revenue Stabilization Act, \$44.7 million dollars from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), an Adequacy Set-Aside in Act 561 for \$45 million dollars, and \$53.2 million dollars from other Set-Asides established in Act 561 for various programs.

The following is a summary of the estimated costs of the LEARNS Act:

- Teacher Salary Increase \$180 million for FY2024 and FY2025.
- Education Freedom Accounts \$46.7 million in FY2024 and \$97.5 million in FY2025, with supplemental funding from the Education Freedom Accounts Set-Aside established in Act 561 for \$15 million dollars.
- Maternity Leave \$3 million for FY2024 and FY2025.
- Innovative Transportation \$5 million starting in FY2025.
- State Teacher Education Program \$1.1 million both fiscal years, for the Division of Higher Education, funded with a Teacher Education Program Set-Aside established in Act 561.
- Teacher Academy Scholarship Fund \$12 million both fiscal years, for the Division of Higher Education, funded with a Teacher Academy Scholarship Set-Aside established in Act 561.
- Literacy Coaches \$6.2 million both fiscal years, to be funded with ARPA funds.
- Supplemental Education Services \$8.5 both fiscal years, to be funded with ARPA funds.
- Merit Teacher Incentive Fund \$10 million both fiscal years, to be funded with ARPA funds.
- High Impact Tutoring \$20 million both fiscal years, to be funded with ARPA funds.
- Charter School Facilities \$10 to \$12 million funded with a Charter School Facilities Set-Aside established in Act 561.

FUNDING FOR ACT 659 – THE PROTECT ARKANSAS ACT

The following is a summary of the funding associated with the Protect Arkansas Act:

- Act 561 established the "Correctional Facilities Set-Aside", in the amount of \$330 million for the Correctional Facilities related cost that may be released from time to time as requested by the Department of Corrections and approved by the Arkansas Legislative Council.
- The Prosecutor Coordinator's Office will establish a statewide certified facility dog program to assist child and vulnerable victims and child and vulnerable witnesses throughout the criminal justice system, known as the Paws for Justice program, at an estimated cost of \$600,000.
- The Administrative Office of the Courts will implement the expansion or establishment of specialty court programs in circuit courts with an estimated cost of \$4.5 million to be funded from the State Central Services Fund.
- DHS Division of Aging, Adult and Behavioral Health Services may establish and maintain a mental health program to provide restoration services in a secure setting for defendants who have been found to lack fitness to proceed and are not in an acute phase of illness requiring the services of a psychiatric hospital, at an estimated cost of \$2.25 million, funded from the Revenue Stabilization Act.
- The Department of Corrections Sentencing Commission will provide training associated with the Protect Arkansas Act, at an estimated cost of \$100,000, funded from the Revenue Stabilization Act.

<u>Personnel Related Legislation Enacted – 2023 Regular Session</u>

The Uniform Classification and Compensation Act for Departments and Agencies Act 886 of 2023 (SB565)

- Section 1 was amended to remove a sunset date for the listed classifications.
 This eliminates the requirement to address the listed classifications each session. That section will only be adjusted if needed.
- Section 2 increased the number of Surrender Pool positions from 700 to 1500. This will provide the legislature and the executive branch the flexibility to adjust positions as needed during the interim.
- Section 3 creates the option for employees at the maximum salary level of their assigned grade to receive a Merit Increase that will exceed the maximum. OPM must receive approval from Legislative Council prior to paying over the maximum by providing a list of all employees who will receive the salary increases.

The Uniform Classification and Compensation Act for Institutions of Higher Education Act 778 of 2023 (SB491)

- During the fall hearings all institutions were approved to move graded positions to unclassified (line item maximum) positions.
- Due to the change in position status for all institutions, Act 778 eliminates all language related to Higher Education in Arkansas Code under Title 21, Chapter 5, Subchapter 14 of the Arkansas Code.
- Included in the elimination of Subchapter 14 is the need for a "Pay Plan" for the positions at Institutions of Higher Education, because they no longer have pay grades.
- Language that needed to be retained was moved to Title 6, Chapter 63, Subchapter 3 of the Arkansas Code.
- Included in transfer of language was new language the created a "Surrender Pool" for the institutions to be maintained by the Division of Higher Education.

2023 Regular Session Fiscal Legislation Summary Cabinet Departments

DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

Agriculture

Act 873 (SB83)

- The Department has a total authorized appropriation of \$87,985,163 in FY2024 with (602) authorized positions and is funded with Special Revenues, General Revenue, Cash Funds and Federal Funds.
- Amendment deleted Agri Scholarship Program appropriation and replaced with a new appropriation from a new scholarship fund, the Agri Scholarship Program Fund created by Act 706 of 2023, and added an appropriation line for \$30,000 for a rural veterinary scholarship program.

Natural Resources Commission

Act 571 (HB1169)

• The Commission has a total authorized appropriation of \$130,788,870 in FY2024 with (68) authorized positions and is funded with Special Revenues, Federal Revenue, Cash Funds and General Revenue.

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

Economic Development Commission

Act 605 (SB32)

• The Cabinet Department has a total authorized appropriation of \$529,741,861 in FY2024 with (132) authorized positions and is funded with Bond Proceeds, Federal Revenue, General Revenue, Cash and Trust Funds.

Act 810 (HB1505)

• Establishes an \$8,000,000 cash appropriation in FY2024 for the Rural Arkansas Economic Development Initiative for grants and operational expenses.

Act 359 (SB315)

• Established \$950,000 in cash appropriation in FY2024 for a feasibility study for a spaceport.

Aeronautics Division

Act 16 (SB19)

• The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$27,684,887 in FY2024 with (5) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Revenue, Special Revenue (a tax on the sale of aviation fuels and aviation related products sold in the state) and Fund Balances.

Bank Department

Act 488 (HB1072)

The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$12,498,341 in FY2024 with (78) authorized positions and is funded with Special Revenue (generated by semi-annual assessments of all financial institutions under the supervisory authority of the Division) and Fund Balances.

Development Finance Authority

Act 394 (HB1071)

• The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$60,408,344 in FY2024 with (56) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Revenue, Cash Funds (bond proceeds and funds generated by ADFA programs) and Fund Balances.

Insurance Department

Act 342 (SB29)

The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$118,589,841 in FY2024 with (189) authorized positions and is funded with Fund Balances, Trust Funds (interest income, earnings, adjustments, grants refunds, gifts), Miscellaneous Revolving Funds (employer workers' compensation benefits contributions), Federal Revenue and Special Revenue (fees, premiums collected).

Rehabilitation Services

Act 283 (HB1081)

 Rehabilitation Services, including State Services for the Blind, has a total authorized appropriation of \$73,785,229 in FY2024 with (445) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Revenue, General Revenue, Fund Balances, Special Revenue, Cash Funds and program income from cafeteria fees, contributions, reimbursements, interest income and institutional services.

Securities Department

Act 281 (HB1079)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$4,099,682 in FY2024 with (36) authorized positions and is funded with Fund Balances, Special Revenue (filing fees, fines), and Cash Funds.
- Act 475 of 2023 transferred the administrative functions of the Securities Department to the Bank Department.

Waterways Commission

Act 23 (HB1063)

- The Commission has a total authorized appropriation of \$7,333,344 in FY2024 with (3) authorized positions and is funded with Ad Valorem Taxes, Fund Balances and General Revenue.
- Act 881 of 2023 revised portions of the AR Port, Intermodal and Waterways Development Grant Program.

Workforce Services Division

Act 606 (SB33)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$2,270,151,377 in FY2024 with (987) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Revenue, Educational Excellence Trust Funds, the Stabilization Tax, General Revenue, Employer Penalties and Interest, Career and Technical Education Public School Fund, Advance Interest Funds and Fund Balances.
- Amendment changes special language so the amount transferred from the Division of Workforce Services Training Trust Fund to the Skills Development Fund is up to \$2,500,000.
- Amendment increases the appropriation amount for grants to Literacy Councils from \$675,000 to \$1,000,000.

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION

Division of Correction

Act 890 (HB1176)

- The Cabinet Department and Division of Correction have a total authorized appropriation of \$587,479,434 in FY2024 with (4,744) authorized positions and is funded from General Revenue, Special Revenue from fees, and State Central Services Funds.
- Governor's Letter #27 upgraded various positions within the Department and provided an additional \$20,000,000 in appropriation for Medical Contracts.
- The Governor line item vetoed a \$5 million line item for Pandemic Expenses.

Act 118 (HB1362)

Provides supplemental appropriation of \$5 million for FY2023 for overtime.

Division of Community Correction

Act 285 (HB1134)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$136,444,894 in FY2024 with (1,545) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Federal Revenue, Special Revenue, and Cash Funds.
- Governor's Letter #6 added \$2,700,000 total in operating expense appropriation for vehicle replacement within the Division.

Parole Board

Act 861 (SB44)

• The Board has a total authorized appropriation of \$2,434,967 in FY2024 with (22) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue.

Sentencing Commission

Act 607 (SB45)

- The Commission has a total authorized appropriation of \$495,515 in FY2023 with (3) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue.
- Amendment added \$100,000 in operating expense appropriation for training related to Act 659 of 2023 the Protect Arkansas Act.

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

Division of Elementary & Secondary Education

Act 871 (SB76)

- The Cabinet Department has a total authorized appropriation of \$1,929,722,780 in FY2024 with (404) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Revenue, Fund Balances, Cash Funds and General Revenue.
- Governor's Letter #16 requested the following amendment to provide for the implementation and appropriation of items passed in Act 294 of 2023 the LEARNS Act.
 - ADE Shared Services

Two new positions are added to the ADE Shared Services Salary Section -1 ADE Chief of Staff and 1 ADE Chief Legal Counsel -\$357,892 in associated salaries and matching costs are added to the ADE Shared Services Appropriation for these two positions.

State Operations

-15 vacant positions are surrendered and 8 new positions are added included two new titles: ADE Associate Deputy (3), ADE Program Director (1), and 4 positions are added to the existing ADE Coordinator of Special Programs. The Changes in positions result in a net decrease of overall \$291,284 annually in the State Operations appropriation.

- Education Revolving Loan Certificates Program
 \$10 Million appropriation is added for the greation a
 - \$10 Million appropriation is added for the creation and administration of the Open-Enrollment Public Charter Schools Revolving Loan program.
- Professional Licensure Standards Board
 - 1 Position is surrendered from the Regular Salary Section along with an associated reduction of \$62,212 in salaries and matching appropriation for the eliminated position.
- Succeed Scholarship Program
 - \$3 Million Appropriation for the Succeed Scholarship Program is deleted.
- Educational Freedom Accounts
 - Appropriation is added for \$52.1 Million for Educational Freedom Accounts payable from the "Arkansas Children's Educational Freedom Account Fund"

Act 678 (SB331)

 Provides \$25,000,000 in a treasury cash appropriation to ADE - Division of Elementary and Secondary Education for "After School and Summer Program Grants"

Act 679 (SB332)

 Provides \$10,000,000 in a treasury cash appropriation to ADE - Division of Elementary and Secondary Education for "After School and Summer Program Grants for Boys and Girls Clubs Statewide"

Educational Television Division (AETN)

Act 428 (HB1078)

The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$19,240,873 in FY2024 with (102) authorized positions and is funded with Cash Revenues, General Revenue and Fund Balances.

Career and Technical Education Division

Act 867 (SB61)

• The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$55,117,606 in FY2024 with (44) authorized positions and is funded with Public School Funds, Fund Balances, Federal Revenue, Educational Excellence Trust Fund and General Revenue.

Higher Education Division

Act 870 (SB75)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$131,135,830 in FY2024 with (134) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Fund Balances, Education Excellence Trust Fund Revenues, Federal Revenue and Special Revenues.
- Amendment adds \$9,600,000 in appropriation for the Graduate Medical Residency Expansion Program appropriation.
- Amendment provides for the deletion of a proposed Code Amendment that would require institutions of higher education to be subject to audit by Arkansas Legislative Audit upon request of the Division of Higher Education.
- Governor's Letter #16 provides for the following changes in the ADE-DHE Appropriation bill to provide for the implementation of Arkansas LEARNS:
 - O Adds 1 "DHE Program Specialist" position to the Regular Salaries Section for the Division of Higher Education, with an increase in \$68,693 in associated salaries and matching cost in the General Operations Appropriation for the position. This is for an administrator of the "Arkansas Teacher Academy Scholarship Program" established by Arkansas LEARNS.
 - Adds an additional \$2 Million in appropriation for the "State Teacher Student Education Program" to provide for anticipated increases due to the passage of Arkansas LEARNS.
 - Adds a new appropriation section appropriating \$12 Million for the creation and administration Arkansas Teacher Academy Scholarship Program established by Arkansas LEARNS.

Martin Luther King Jr. Commission

Act 568 (HB1132)

• The Commission has a total authorized appropriation of \$441,071 in FY2024 with (4) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue and Cash Funds.

<u>Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation Division</u>

Act 860 (SB36)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$218,327,388 in FY2024 with (32) authorized positions and is funded with Fund Balances, General Revenue, the Education Partnership Fund and transfers from the Public School Fund.
- Governor's Letter #16 provides an additional "ADE PROGRAM ADMINISTRATOR" position. Associated Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching costs are also added for this position in the 2WB (DPSAFT Operations) appropriation.

Public School Fund (K-12 Funding)

Act 572 (HB1170)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$3,465,009,628 in FY2024 with (49) authorized positions and is funded with the Department of Education Public School Fund, Educational Adequacy Fund, Educational Excellence Trust Fund and Fund Balances.
- Governor's Letter #16 requests the following changes for appropriation due to the passage of Arkansas LEARNS to the Public School Fund Appropriation:
 - o Removes \$2.1 Million in appropriation for Teacher Recruitment
 - Adds \$203 Million in appropriation for new programs established by the Arkansas LEARNS Act:
 - -\$3 Million for Maternity Leave
 - -\$10 Million for Merit Teacher Incentives
 - -\$190 Million for Minimum Teacher Salary and Raises

Schools for the Blind and Deaf

Act 869 (SB73)

• The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$24,798,773 in FY2024 with (248) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Fund Balances, Federal Revenues and Cash Funds.

State Library

Act 566 (HB1093)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$17,430,988 in FY2024 with (49) authorized positions and is funded with Public School Funds, General Revenue, Federal Revenue, Fund Balances and Other Funds.
- New Special Language is added allows the State Library to modify rules for state library aid to allow local public libraries to demonstrate other forms of revenue when determining eligibility for state aid.

DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT

Division of Environmental Quality

Act 570 (HB1167)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$166,797,454 in FY2024 with (417) authorized positions and is funded with Special Revenue from various fees and penalties; Federal Revenue from grants from the Environmental Protection Agency and US Department of the Interior; and General Revenue.
- Governor's Letter #14 transferred one position and \$58,036 of associated Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching appropriation from the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board to the Department of Energy and Environment Shared Services

Geological Survey

Act 868 (SB64)

- The Agency has a total authorized appropriation of \$3,069,563 in FY2024 with (22) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Federal Revenue, and Nonrevenue Receipts from sale of maps to the public.
- Governor's Letter #19 changed the fund source for State Operations from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund to the Oil and Gas Commission Fund due to the passage of Act 697 of 2023 which abolished Geological Survey and created the Office of State Geologist within the Oil and Gas Commission.

Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board

Act 19 (SB63)

• The Board has a total authorized appropriation of \$625,611 in FY2024 with (6) authorized positions and is funded with Special Revenue from license, permit, and inspection fees.

Oil and Gas Commission

Act 28 (HB1138)

• The Commission has a total authorized appropriation of \$529,207 in FY2024 with (34) authorized positions and is funded with Special Revenue from oil and gas assessments, permit and application fees, and brine taxes.

DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

Finance and Administration

Act 478 (HB1084)

- The Cabinet Department has a total authorized appropriation of \$1,522,191,280 in FY2024 with (1,841) authorized positions and is funded with State Central Services Funds, Federal Funds, Cash Funds, Fund Balances, Non-Revenue Receipts, Inter-agency Transfers, General Revenue, Tax Refunds and Special Revenues.
- Governor's Letter #22 increases appropriation for Information Technology Services line item by \$8.5 million and changes name of Revenue Services Division - Commercial Driver's License Program appropriation section to Driver Services/Motor Vehicles Program due to the passage of Act 478 of 2023.

Assessment Coordination Division

Act 370 (SB23)

The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$19,580,919 in FY2024 with (33) authorized positions and is funded with fund transfers to the Real Property Reappraisal Fund from the Public School Fund, Municipal Aid Funds, County Aid Funds, Fund Balances, Ad Valorem Taxes, General Revenue, County Assessors Continuing Education Fund and Cash Funds.

Child Support Enforcement

Act 280 (HB1075)

• The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$74,548,376 in FY2024 with (775) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Funds, General Revenue and State share of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) collections.

Disbursing Officer

Act 796 (HB1096)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$12,672,169,812 in FY2024 with no authorized positions and is funded with Special Revenue, State Administration of Justice Funds, General Revenue, Federal Funds, Trust Funds, M&R proceeds and Workforce 2000 Funds.
- Amendment provides \$400,000 in appropriation for a new line item for the Morgan Nick Foundation and
- Amendments creates a new appropriation section that provides \$3.5 million for the Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Crime Task Force Appropriation that is funded by Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account.
- Amendment provides \$240,000 in appropriation for equal disbursements to Arkansas Economic Development Districts.
- Governor's Letter #21 increases appropriation for Personal Services Overtime line item by \$4 million for a total of \$10 million, increases Cash Appropriation - Various Cash Agencies line item by \$450 million for a total of \$750 million, increases Various Temporary Appropriation for State Agencies and Institutions by \$400 million for a total of \$750 million and increases Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act of 2021 Section by \$2,95 billion for a total of \$3.5 billion to ensure there is sufficient appropriation in Fiscal Year 2024.

Act 119 (HB1363)

 Supplemental appropriation provides \$2,000,000 to the Personal Services Overtime line item and \$750,000,000 to the Miscellaneous Federal Grants line item for Fiscal Year 2023 to provide sufficient appropriation for constitutional officers and various state agencies.

Act 622 (SB286)

- Establishes a \$1,000,000 appropriation for FY2024, payable from the Pregnancy Help Organization Sub-Fund in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for grants for Pregnancy Help Organizations.
- Amendment clarifies how the grants will be disbursed and that the funding will come from the established Sub-Fund in Miscellaneous Agencies and that any funds not expended after June 30, 2024 will be transferred to the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund.
- Clause establishes that special language sections defining the program and the funding transfer of appropriation are effective upon passage and approval.

Regulatory Division

Act 489 (HB1074)

• The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$37,619,438 in FY2024 with (84) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Cash Funds, Federal Funds and Special Revenue.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

Health Department

Act 565 (HB1092)

The Cabinet Department has a total authorized appropriation of \$603,617,337 in FY2024 with (2,242) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Federal Revenue, Special Revenue (licensing and certification fees), Fees (health-related documents and services provided by Local Health Units), Third Party Reimbursements (Medicaid, Medicare, private Insurance), Manufacturer Rebates, Fund Balances and Tobacco Settlement Funds.

Health Department - Tobacco Prevention and Cessation

Act 282 (HB1080)

• The Health Department - Tobacco Prevention and Cessation has a total authorized appropriation of \$14,575,685 in FY202 with (31) authorized positions and is funded with Tobacco Settlement Funds and Fund Balances.

Health Services Permit Agency

Act 24 (HB1073)

• The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$491,946 in FY2024 with (4) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Special Revenue (fees from certificate of need applications) and Fund Balances.

Licensing and Regulation Boards

Act 859 (SB31)

- The Licensing and Regulation Boards has a total authorized appropriation of \$15,819,092 in FY2024 with (118) authorized positions and is funded with Cash Funds (license, renewal and examination fees), Special Revenue (fees, penalties), Fund Balances, General Revenue, Interest and Investments.
- Amendment increases operating expense line item for State Board of Pharmacy by \$100,000 and decreases the professional fees line item by \$100,000 to better reflect the Board's needs.
- Amendment increases the amount of contributions by various Boards for educational programs that provide for identification, treatment and monitoring of healthcare professionals who suffer from alcohol or drug abuse programs. Contributions: Medical Board: increase of \$10 from \$25 to \$35, Board of Dental examiners: \$15, Board of Podiatric Medicine: \$10.
- Amendment adds an appropriation of \$150,000 to the Psychology Board for a scholarship program for psychology students pursuing training as psychological and neuropsychological technicians.

Act 680 (SB336)

• Appropriates \$200,000 in FY2024 for a scholarship program for the Arkansas State Board of Physical Therapy.

 The Commission has a total authorized appropriation of \$286,533 in FY2024 with (3) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Fund Balances and Cash Funds

Minority Health Initiative

Act 17 (SB21)

• The Minority Health Initiative of the Targeted State Needs Program has a total authorized appropriation of \$1,787,407 in FY2024 with (6) authorized positions and is funded with Tobacco Settlement Funds and Fund Balances.

Tobacco Settlement Commission

Act 603 (SB20)

• The Commission has a total authorized appropriation of \$351,760 in FY2024 with (1) authorized positions and is funded with Tobacco Settlement Interest Earnings.

DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES

Secretary's Office

Act 492 (HB1118)

- The Cabinet Department has a total authorized appropriation of \$85,335,431 in FY2024 with (663) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Funds, General Revenues, Fund Balances and Other Funds (cost allocation plan, reimbursements).
- Governor's Letter #9 increases the total number of positions by 1, with no associated appropriation, to encompass changes made through reallocations of resources and to reclassify two positions to provide leadership titles necessary within the Department. It also continues the number of reallocations of resources that Department is allowed at 4 per fiscal year in the Transfer Authority special language section.
- Governor's Letters #9 and #15 amend codified special language to delete references to titles that are no longer utilized for the Nursing/Direct Care Education Stipend Program and Nursing/Direct Care Recruitment/Retention Bonuses.

Aging, Adult, and Behavioral Health Services Division

Act 866 (SB54)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$275,644,432 in FY2024 with (1,154) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Federal Funds and Other Funds (grant funds, fees and fines, reimbursements).
- Governor's Letter #11 reclassifies 33 positions from the "Registered Nurse Hospital" title to the "Registered Nurse" title in order to attract and retain qualified individuals. In the Operations appropriation, deletes the Foster Grandparent line item and reallocates that appropriation amount to the Capital Outlay line item due to the discontinuation of the Foster Grandparent program.

Child Care and Early Childhood Education Division

Act 864 (SB52)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$270,485,070 in FY2024 with (184) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Funds and General Revenue.
- Governor's Letter #20 adds a new appropriation section of \$53 million in federal appropriation in order to facilitate the move of the division to the Department of Education as a result of the LEARNS Act (Act 237 of 2023).

Children and Family Services Division

Act 609 (SB55)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$312,526,635 in FY2024 with (1,422) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Funds, General Revenue and Fund Balances.
- Governor's Letter #10 adds (2) "Administrative Specialist" positions to incorporate changes made in earlier reallocation of resources.

County Operations Division

Act 798 (HB1119)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$196,151,759 in FY2024 with (1,834) authorized positions and is funded with Federal Funds, General Revenue and Other Funds (collection, fees, reimbursements, Title XIX match).
- Governor's Letter #14 deletes one "DHS/DCO Assistant Director" position, encompassing position changes made during the interim.
- Governor's Letter #24 adds 40 positions to the Regular Salaries section and adds an
 appropriation section for \$2.6 million funded from the Tobacco Settlement in order "to
 better align integrated eligibility case work...with its personnel and funding.". These
 positions and the appropriation were previously associated with the division in the
 Medicaid Tobacco Settlement Program appropriation bill (Act 797 of 2023).

Developmental Disabilities Services Division

Act 863 (SB51)

- The Division has a total authorized appropriation of \$211,140,094 in FY2024 with (2,535) authorized positions and is funded with General Revenue, Federal Funds and Other Funds (special education funds, targeted case management and Medicaid reimbursements).
- Governor's Letter #13 reclassifies 10 titles from "Licensed Practical Nurse" to "Registered Nurse" to provide a higher quality of care at the division's facilities.
