23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 101, Subchapter 1, is			
24	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:			
25	17-101-104. Animal	Emergency Veterinary Treatment A	<u>ct.</u>	
26	<u>(a) This section s</u>	shall be known and may be cited as	the "Animal	
27	Emergency Veterinary Trea	atment Act".		
28	(b) As used in thi	s section, "emergency medical con	dition" means a	
29	medical condition of suff	ficient severity that the absence	<u>of immediate</u>	
30	medical attention could r	reasonably be expected to result i	<u>n:</u>	
31	(1) Placing	the health of the animal in serio	us jeopardy;	
32	(2) Serious	impairment to bodily functions of	the animal; or	
33	(3) Serious	dysfunction of any bodily organ o	r part of the	
34	animal.			
35	(c) If an animal i	s brought to a veterinary practic	<u>e or veterinarian</u>	
36	and a request is made on	behalf of the animal for examinat	ion or treatment	

1	for an emergency medical condition, the veterinary practice or veterinarian		
2	shall provide an appropriate medical screening examination within the		
3	capability of the veterinary practice or veterinarian to determine whether or		
4	not an emergency medical condition exists.		
5	(d) If the veterinary practice or veterinarian determines after an		
6	appropriate medical screening examination under subsection (c) of this		
7	section that the animal has an emergency medical condition, the veterinary		
8	practice or veterinarian shall provide further medical examination and		
9	treatment as may be required to stabilize the emergency medical condition of		
10	the animal.		
11	(e) A veterinary practice or veterinarian shall not delay an		
12	appropriate medical screening examination under subsection (c) of this		
13	section or further medical examination and treatment under subsection (d) of		
14	this section in order to inquire about the ability of the animal's		
15	representative to pay or the insurance status of the animal.
