21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-57-1507 is amended to read as follows:
24 26-57-1507. Sunset.

25 This subchapter shall expire on July 1, ~~2023~~ 2025, unless extended by
26 the General Assembly.
27

28 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
29 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the current special privilege
30 tax on medical marijuana expires on July 1, 2023; that the General Assembly
31 intends to continue levying the special privilege tax on medical marijuana
32 until July 1, 2025; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure the
33 uninterrupted, consistent, and efficient administration and imposition of the
34 special privilege tax on medical marijuana. Therefore, an emergency is
35 declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the
36 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective



1 on:

2 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

3 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
4 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
5 bill; or

6 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
7 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
